## Normal Pressure Hydrocephalus (NPH)

- ▶ affects 1 in 200 adults over age 50.
- ▶ is often misdiagnosed as Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's disease or vascular dementia.

### **The Department of Neurology at University of Miami Miller School of Medicine has an active NIH funded research study examining outcome in NPH.**

Participants will receive comprehensive neurologic, cognitive, and standardized gait assessments for 6 months following shunt placement. A complete summary of follow-up evaluations will be provided to the referring physician after study completion.

Eligible individuals should be:

- 50 to 85 years old
- Diagnosed with possible or probable NPH
- Surgical candidate who has not been previously shunted
